

What equipment should I report?

- Report all sold items when sold or within 30 days of date sold
- All types of Agricultural, Construction and Outdoor Power Equipment
- All reported sales shall include required information for an accurate detailed report

Why an accurate detailed report?

It is essential for reported sales to include the information required to accurately verify the value of each machine. For example, if the hours are not reported, Iron Solutions cannot adjust for the usage of the machine. A tractor with extensive usage does not carry the same value as a tractor with low hours.

What information is needed for an accurate detailed report?

Information required to be counted as an accurate detailed report includes:

- Sold Date and Store location
- Type, Make, Model (Unknown Types or Makes not accepted)
- Year and/or Serial Number for equipment less than 30 years old
- Hours reading or usage meter reading
- Detailed equipment description with attachments/options
- Sale Type – New or Used; Retail, RPO, Auction or Wholesale
- Resale Cash sold price (do not include over-allowance)
- Advertised or Retail Asking price
- Condition Rating and Reconditioning Amount (if applicable)

What discount do I earn for my next official guide purchase/renewal?

Dealers and Auctioneers who report at least one year of sales and continue to report used equipment sales monthly for each location can earn up to a 20% discount towards an IronGuides user license purchase.
